#### TERMINATION OF AFTERCARE SERVICE

- If you no longer wish to make use of the aftercare services, you are required to give one full month's written notice via email, to stevens@midstreamridgeprimary.co.za, or deliver it by hand to one of the aftercare teachers. If one month's written notice is not received timeously, your account will be debited for the next month.
- Please note that NO CHANGE and/or cancellation regarding Aftercare Attendance for or during the last term of the school year will be accepted.
- All learners must be signed out by his/her aftercare teacher, no learners may be sent to the gate to wait for their parents or guardians. For learners who walk home, parents must please give permission via email to allow the learner to leave school at a certain time each day, which will allow the teacher involved, to sign the learner out. This email can be sent to sherselman66@gmail.com. If your child will be going home with someone else, please communicate with the relevant teacher in advance. If the information is not communicated, your child will not be excused. If your child is absent, please let the relevant teacher know before 09:00 am.
- Please label your child's clothes and belongings so that lost items can be returned to your child.
- Your child's activities (time and place) must be communicated to the relevant teacher.
- The aftercare closes at 17:30. If you are going to be late, please make arrangements so that your child can be collected on time.

#### **Exam Arrangements:**

Gr. 4 and 5 learners will write in their classrooms. Gr. 6 and 7 learners will write in the school hall.

- From 10:00 on Wednesday, 10 November, each learner will be assigned his/her exam desk, where they will sit the entire exam period to write their exams.
- We kindly request that learners be at school promptly at 07:30, to ensure that everyone is ready and calm before we begin the exam.
- From 07:30 07:45, register will be taken followed by Scripture reading and prayer.
- From 07:45 08:00, exam papers will be handed out and reviewed with learners. The Gr. 4 learners' papers will be read to them. We have ensured that learners have enough time to complete their papers.
- Gr. 4 learners must please bring their work to school to learn for the next day's exam.
- School closes at 10:00 for Grade 4 to 7.
- There will be a waiting class from 10:00 until 13:30, where learners can study for the following exam.
- Learners attending aftercare are to report to their respective aftercare classes at 12:00.

#### Illness during exam period:

If a learner falls ill during the exam, the school requires a certified doctor's note. The subject teacher will communicate with parents for the arrangement of when your child will write the exam paper.

#### **TENNIS**


